THE GOLF CLUB AT BALLANTYNE TO HOST BALLANTYNE JUNIOR OPEN IN FEBRUARY

Charlotte, N.C. (January 8, 2015) – More than 100 young golfers from all over the U.S. will tee it up at the 14th Annual Ballantyne Junior Open being hosted again this year by The Golf Club at Ballantyne on Saturday and Sunday, February 7-8. The Open is a 36-hole stroke play golf tournament directed by Marc Lapointe, director of instruction and Molly Tullar Braid, director of junior golf at Dana Rader Golf School.

Junior Golfers are grouped into four categories by age and gender: Boys age 13-14 and 15-18, and Girls age 13-14 and 15-18. Play will begin with a shotgun start at 10 a.m. on February 7, and concludes with a final round on February 8.

Entries must be mailed, and the deadline is 4:30 p.m. on Friday, January 16. The final field will be posted online at www.danarader.com/BallantyneJuniorOpen.cfm by 4:30 p.m. on Saturday, January 17. The field will be determined by various factors: the player's performance in the 2014 Ballantyne Junior Open, national ranking, state ranking, scoring average and/or by special exemption by the tournament committee. The general public is welcome to observe, and admission is free. Tournament results will be posted online the evening of February 7 at www.danarader.com and submitted to various media outlets.

"This is a very real opportunity for junior golfers to play in a competitive atmosphere, "says Marc Lapointe, Tournament Director. "This event is highly anticipated every year. We see new participants and we have returnees year after year. It's great to see these juniors maturing into their golf game."
